PADI INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT COURSE (IDC)

The PADI Instructor Development Course is designed to further develop the leadership and teaching abilities of PADI Divemaster to the Assistant Instructor and Open Water Instructor levels. The PADI IDC provides individuals who already possess instructor-level dive theory, role model watermanship and rescue skills, and leadership abilities with additional training that allows them to implement the PADI system in confined water, classroom and open water environments. The IDC also helps instructor candidates gain a complete understanding of PADI'S educational goals and philosophies. The PADI IDC begins with independent learning and encompasses both the assistant instructor course and the Open Water Scuba Instructor program.

Our goal here at Scubadoo Divers is to prepare instructor candidates to function as PADI Open Water Scuba Instructors. While we try to provide you with the knowledge and information you need to pass the instructors exam, the most important aim of the training is to ensure you become a confident and professional dive educator. We conduct several IDCs and Assistant Instructor programmes each year. The courses last for 7 days. The first 4 days are the AI training package and the last 4 days are the OWSI training package. If you are already qualified as an AI you may participate in the last 4 days only. For an IDC information pack, contact the dive centre.

Emergency First Response Instructor courses are conducted during or after the IDC. It gives candidates a break but also reinforces the teaching techniques that have been introduced during the AI phase of the IDC. This courses enables candidates to teach EFR Primary and Secondary Care, AED, and Care for Children.

What do I need to start?

- PADI Divemaster certification PADI Divemaster (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- Have 60 logged dives that include night, deep and navigation dives
- Proof of CPR training within the last 24 months
- Medical clearance signed by a physician

What will I do?

- Knowledge development through self-study, quizzes, lectures and presentations
- Confined water skill review and assessment, workshops and presentations
- Open water workshops, rescue assessment and candidate presentations
- Have at least 100 logged dives prior to entering a PADI Instructor Exam

How long will it take?

- Times can vary from four days to three weeks or more
